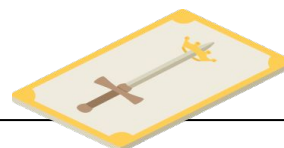

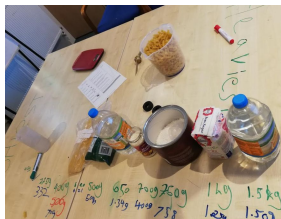


Sensational Soups and Brilliant Breads
