

## **SEN PSHE Teacher/Pastoral Support**

The role would suit a higher level teaching assistant who has solid experience in working with SEN children. Equally the post would suit a qualified teacher looking for a new experience in alternative education. You must be dedicated and interested to improve the outcomes of young people with SEN and a range of complex needs. You will need to be able to build rapport quickly with young people with SEN and complex needs. You will be timetabled and fully part of the teaching team delivering PSHE and interventions. You will need to be flexible and dynamic in your approach, thinking fast on your feet to adapt to the pupil in front of you and know their needs well. You will be a real team member, enthusiastic and able to make the right call with pupils confidently and sensitively. You need to be able to cope with sudden changes and have the confidence to deliver colleagues prepared sessions when covering for staff sickness.

The role is 33.75 hours per week 8.45am – 3.30pm Mon-Fri. In addition, you will attend team training/meetings on a Wednesday 3.45pm-4.45 each week and support in occasional after school events. The salary is inclusive of the usual school holidays (not pro-rata). Candidates will be required to undergo an Enhanced DBS Check.
